

## Alape's top 50 articles are now available as BIM data

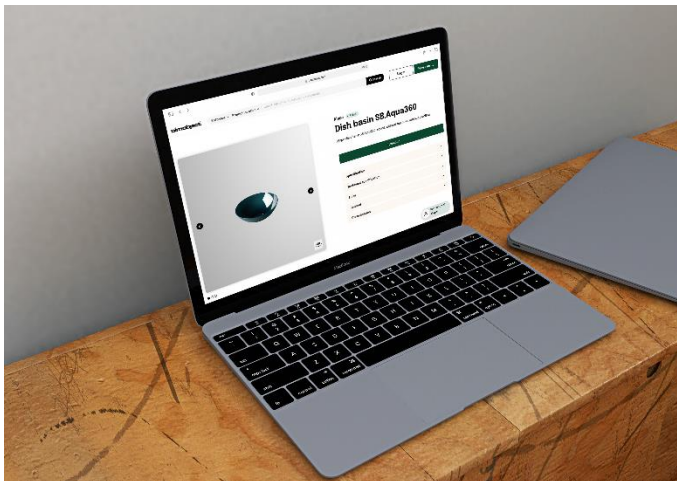
The top 50 articles and their variants, which are now available as BIM data, amount to about 140 articles in total. They range from simple built-in basins to complex washplace solutions. The range of products will be gradually expanded in the future. The data is available in English and German and is offered in detail levels (LOD) 100, 200 and 300. It is also available in all popular formats, such as the international exchange format IFC, and can therefore be used for all major software providers – including ArchiCAD and AutoCAD.

"By making our products available as BIM data, we can now offer the relevant target groups all the combined information that they need: And this in precisely the form that is relevant to them," states Alape managing director Bodo Müller vom Hofe. "By providing the BIM data, we are relying on the planning method of the future while supporting architects and planners in their daily work."

Building information modelling is a high-precision method for the virtual modelling of construction projects. The comprehensive data on which the 3D models are based contain significantly more information than the databases used up until now: **They provide information** on all architectural, technical, physical, and functional properties of a construction project. BIM planning allows everyone involved to always keep track of the different phases of the project – saving time, lowering risks, and reducing costs.
