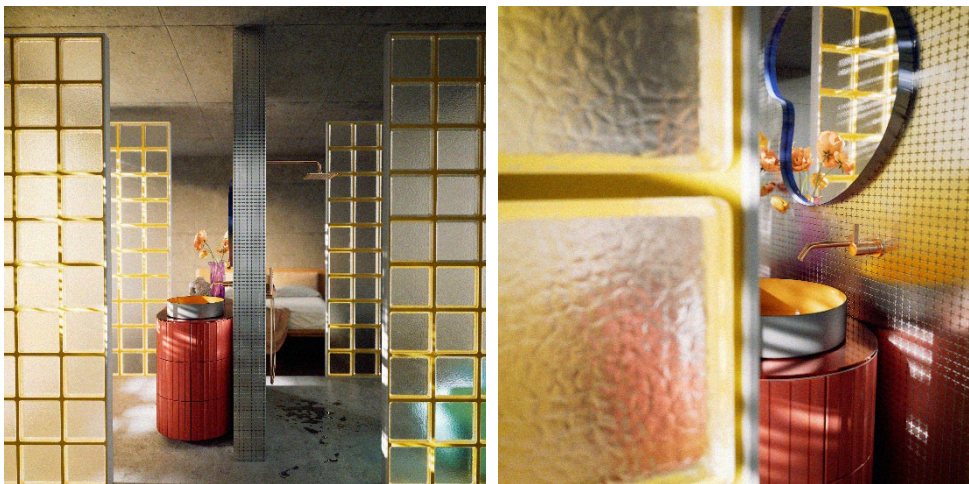


## Life in vibrant hues: Tricolor from Alape

You might want a dynamic look that blends several brightly coloured elements to generate impact, or a calmer atmosphere with splashes of colour creating subtle accents – either way, the three-coloured basin allows you to tailor your bathroom to your own tastes.

In addition to the play of colours, varied textures are another hallmark feature of the Tricolor design, with smooth enamel set against rough glazed steel. The contrast between matte and glossy surfaces is appealing both to the eye and to the touch, taking your washplace to a whole new sensory level. Tricolor is available in three different colour combinations: Tuscany, Petrol and Olive.
